



Chronology Kingdom of Morocco Contribution In financing Bayt Mal Al-Quds Asharif Agency 1998 – 2020

The total amount is 36.7 million dollars, which represents 87% of the countries' donations



The Kingdom of Morocco allocated its first direct financial contribution of 1.10 million \$ to finance projects in Jerusalem.

2000: The Kingdom of Morocco granted a second contribution of 2.8 million \$;

2007: As of this year, it was decided upon royal instructions of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, Chairman of Al-Quds Committee, to allocate an amount of about one million dollars annually to cover the expenses of running the agency, that is, a total of about 13 million dollars.

2008: The Kingdom of Morocco allocated 3.4 million dollars to contribute to financing the celebration of Al-Quds as a capital of Arab culture for the year 2009. An amount of 2.4 million dollars of it was allocated to finance projects in Jerusalem.

2009: The agency received an amount of 9.4 million \$, which was distributed as follows:

-700 000 \$ to implement projects in Jerusalem;

-3.2 million \$ to finance projects in Gaza following the 2009 aggression;

-5.5 million \$ was allocated by His Majesty King Mohamed VI, from his own money, to finance the construction of the Hassan II College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences in Beit Hanoun, after it was completely destroyed following the 2009 aggression on Gaza.

2010: His Majesty King Mohammed VI, Chairman of Al-Quds Committee, may God protect him, handed over a financial grant of 6 million \$ to the Agency, during a ceremony chaired by His Majesty in the Royal Palace in Fez on April 29, 2010. This grant was allocated to fund projects in Jerusalem, in addition to 550,000 \$ was allocated to launch the Jerusalemite orphan sponsorship program. (500 orphans).

2013: The Kingdom of Morocco covered the expenses of the consultative meeting, which was organized with the attendance of Jerusalemite personalities representing social institutions and economic actors, with an amount of 152,000 \$.

2008 - 2020: His Majesty King Mohammed VI, may God protect him, Chairman of Al-Quds Committee, kindly takes care of the expenses of the summer camp, organized by the agency annually for the benefit of Jerusalemite children (50 beneficiaries). The total of these expenses in the part covered by the agency amounted to 800 thousand dollars.
